## **Dordt Discovery Days Camp Anaphylaxis Protocol**

If an exposure is suspected but NO signs/symptoms of anaphylaxis are present:

- 1. Give diphenhydramine
- 2. Alert the camp director of exposure
- 3. Continuously monitor individual for a minimum of 30 minutes
- 4. If symptoms develop/progress, notify EMS.

When signs/symptoms of anaphylaxis are present:

- 1. Activate EMS
- 2. If a patent/open airway, give 50 mg diphenhydramine by mouth
- 3. Notify camp director
- 4. Monitor individual until EMS arrives
- 5. Contact parents, using phone numbers on the camper's health history form.
