Graduation Rate: reflects the percentage of students in a starting cohort that completed their degree at Dordt University. Percentages are provided for those who started a degree program 3-years, 4-years, 5-years and 6-years before and completed the degree by August 1 of the reporting year. The overall rate is for students who completed their degree at Dordt University. The table of reporting years is shown below. Years in *italics* indicate expected graduation dates. Any data provided for these years reflect completions to date for current student cohorts.

A.A. Rate: reflects the number of students who entered an associates degree program three years before the reporting year and completed their degree by August 1 of that year.

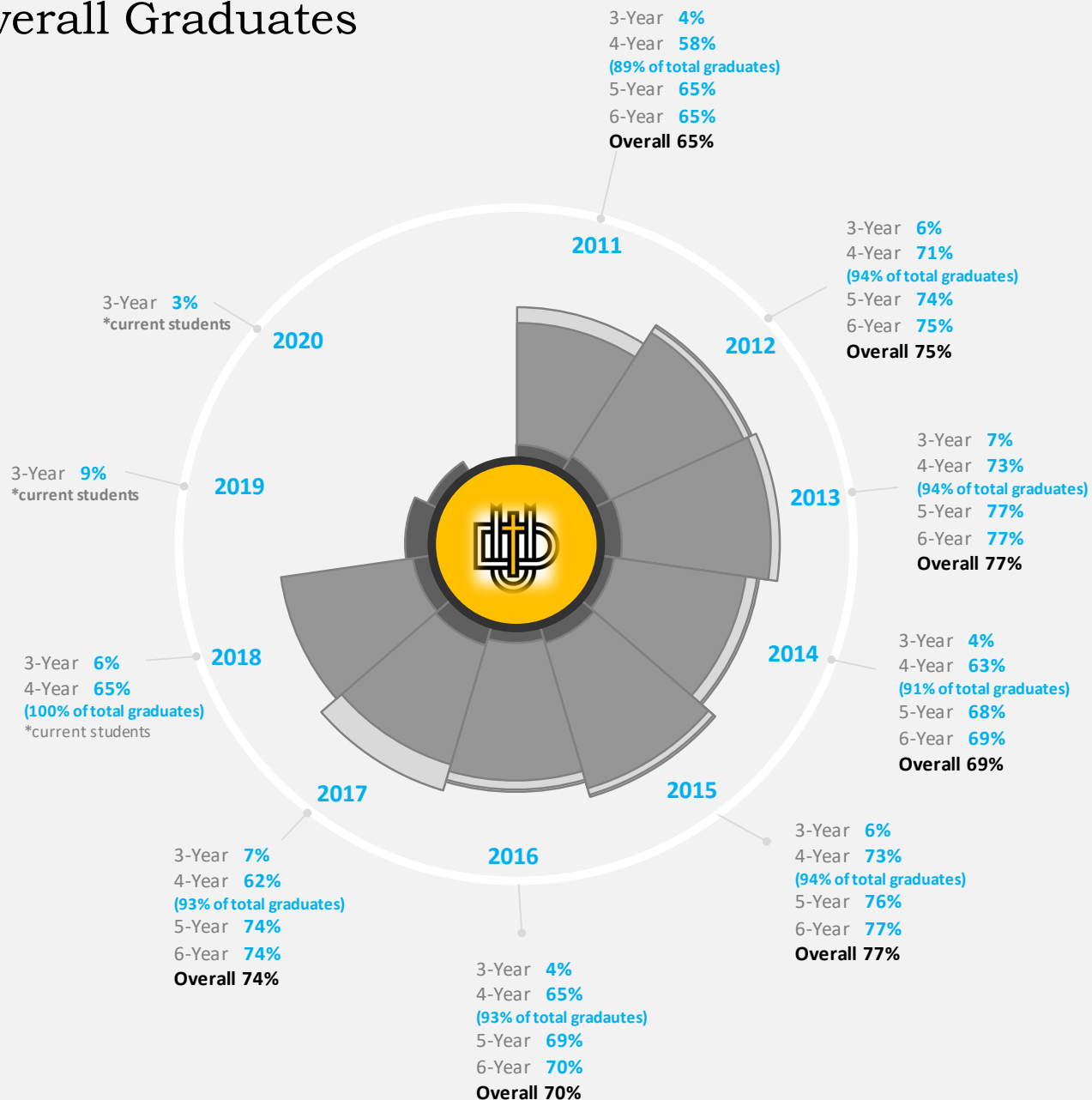
B.A. Rate: reflects the number of students who entered a bachelors degree program six years before the reporting year and completed their degree by August 1 of that year.

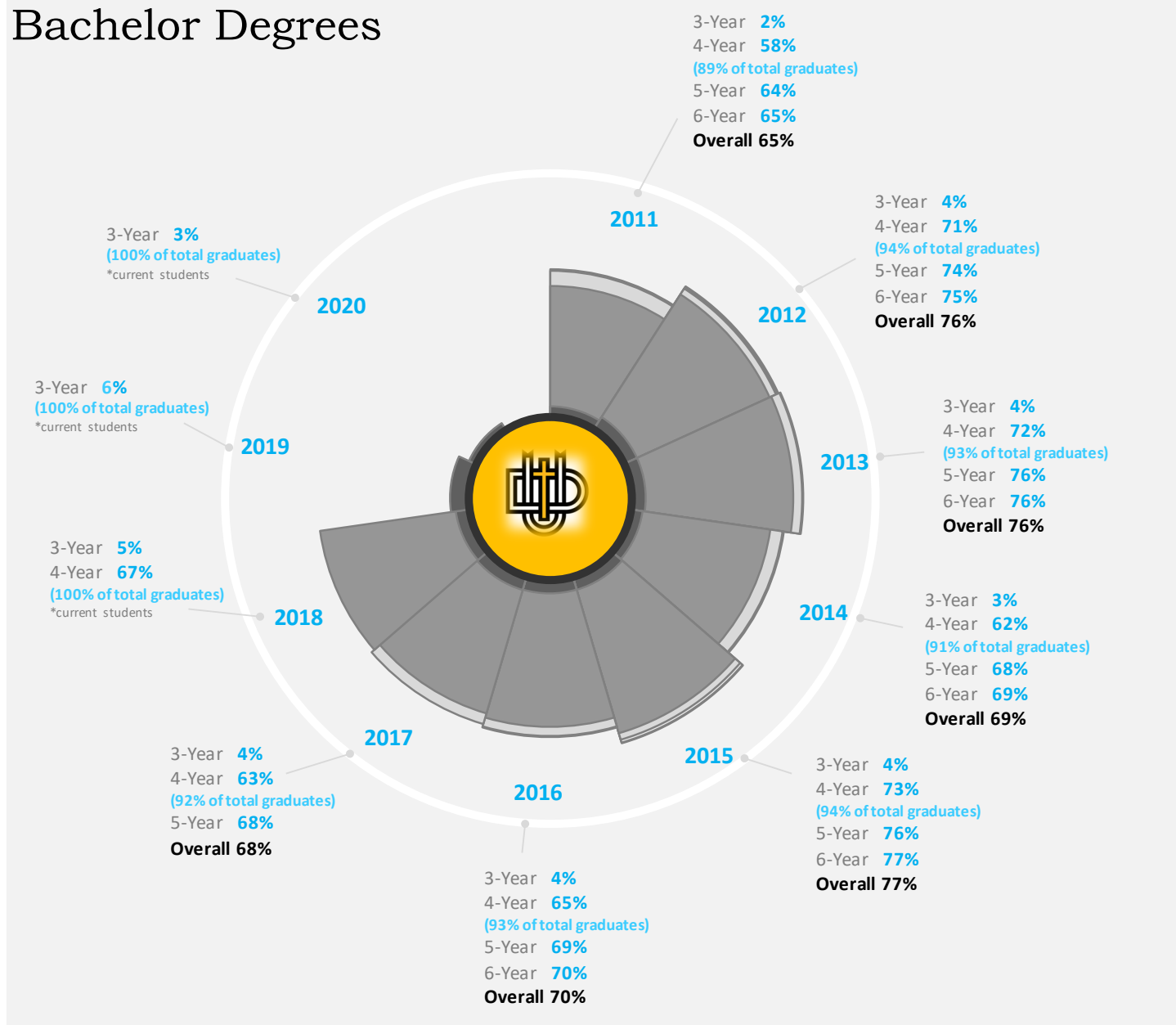

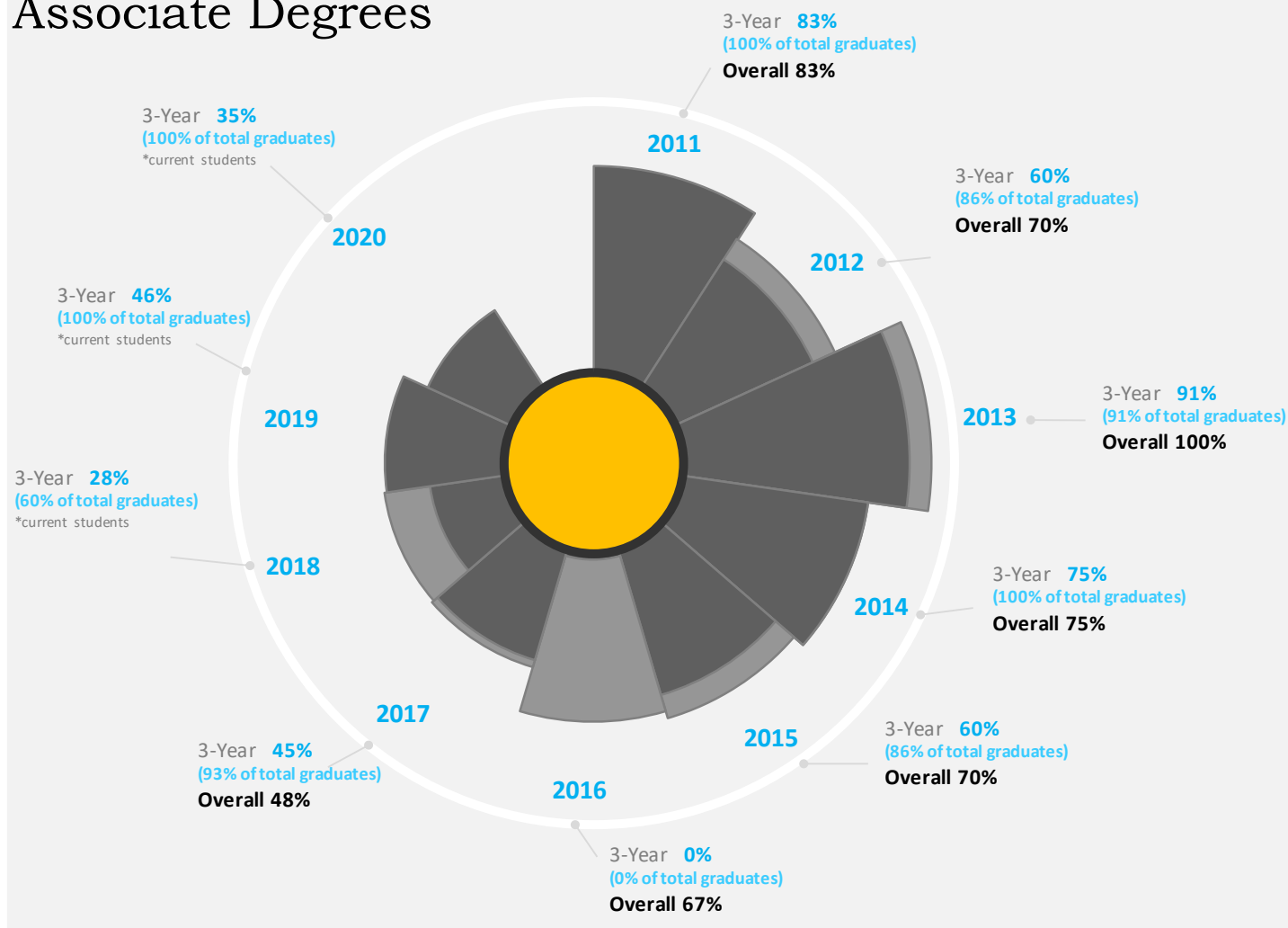

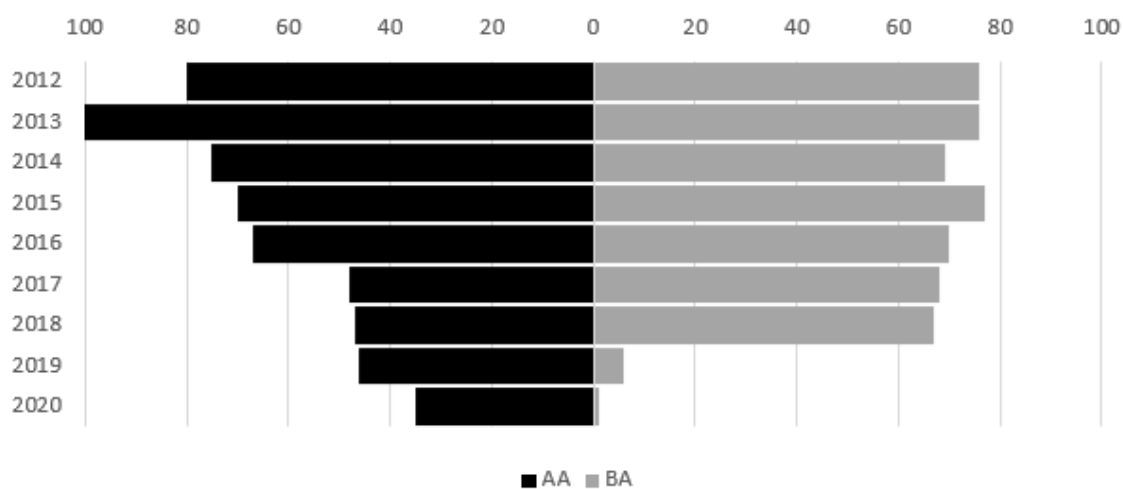

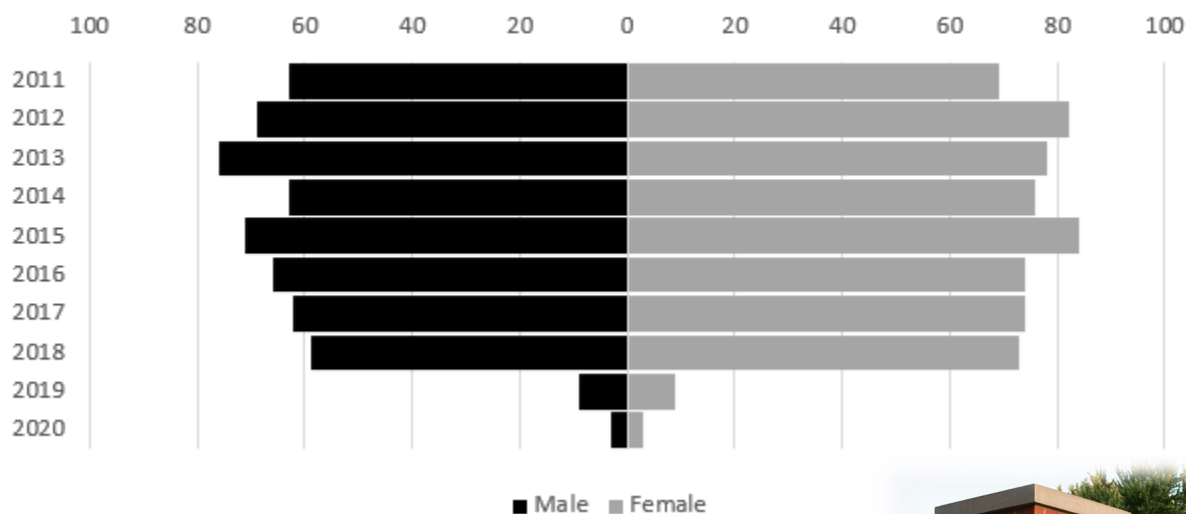

Overall Graduation Rate by Degree Type

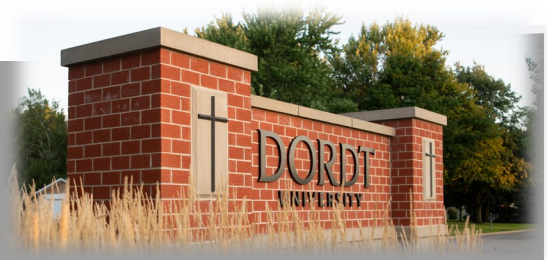

Overall Graduation Rate by Gender



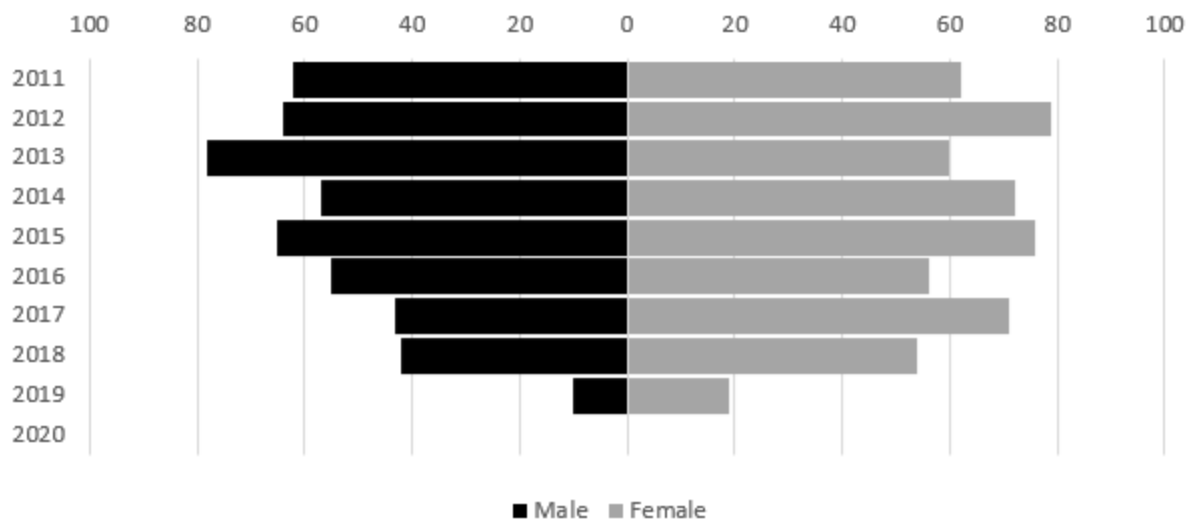

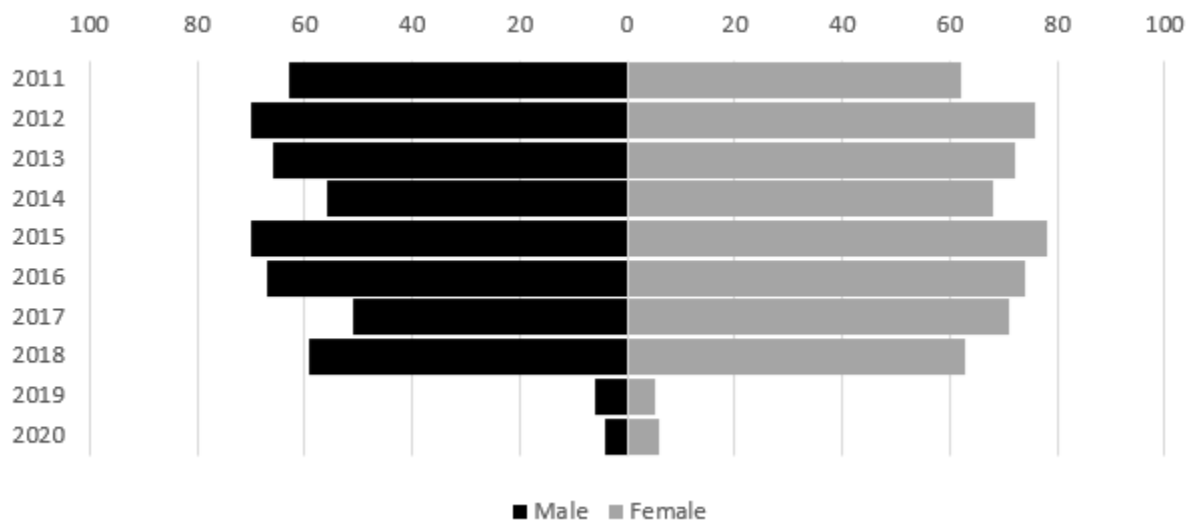

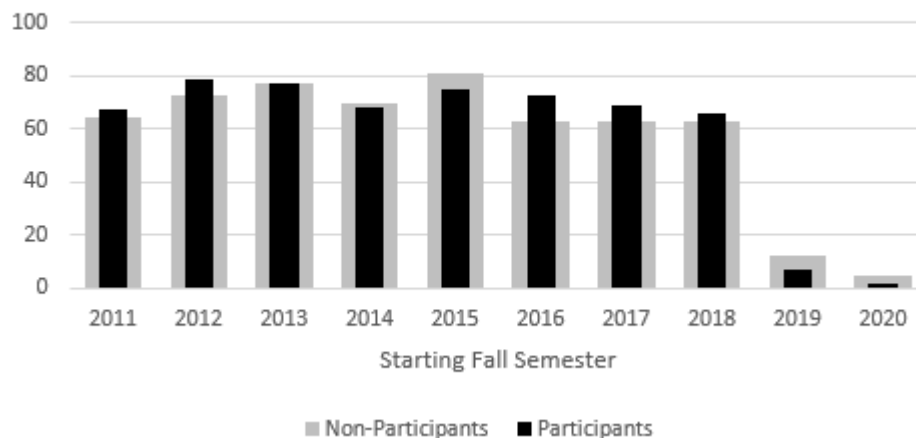

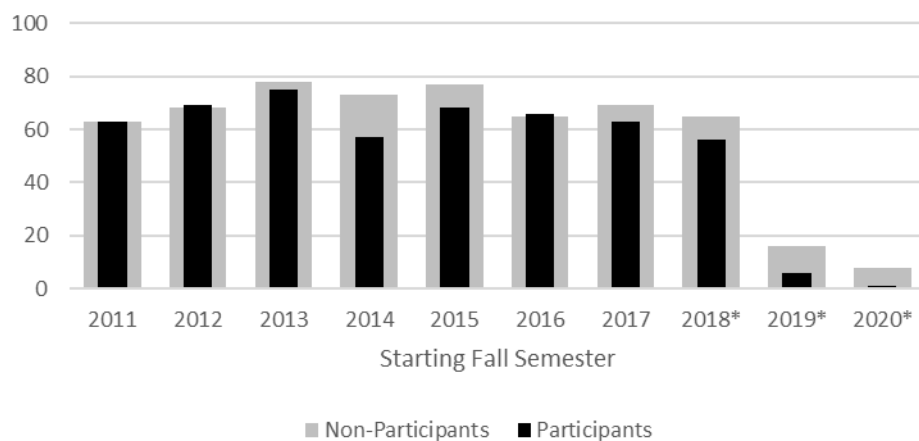

Co-Curricular Participants vs. Non-Participants Graduation Rates



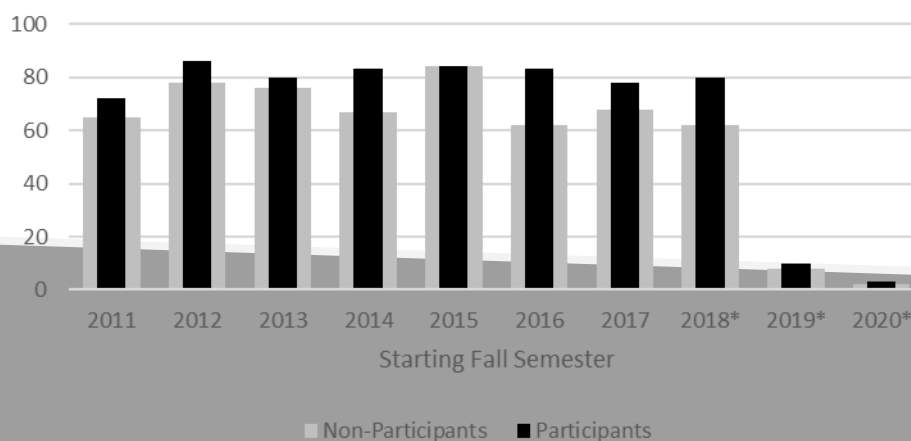
Male Co-Curricular Participants vs. Non-Participants Graduation Rates

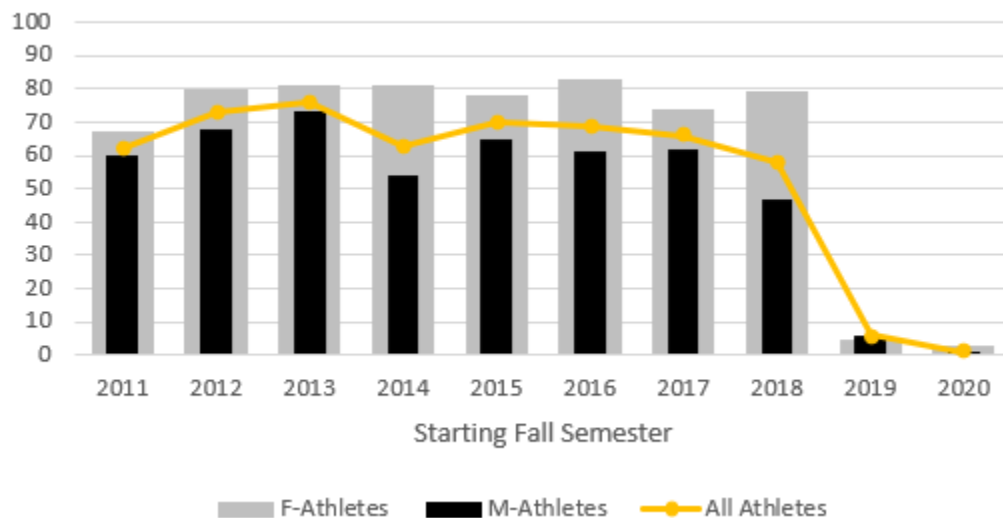
Female Co-Curricular Participants vs. Non-Participants Graduation Rates



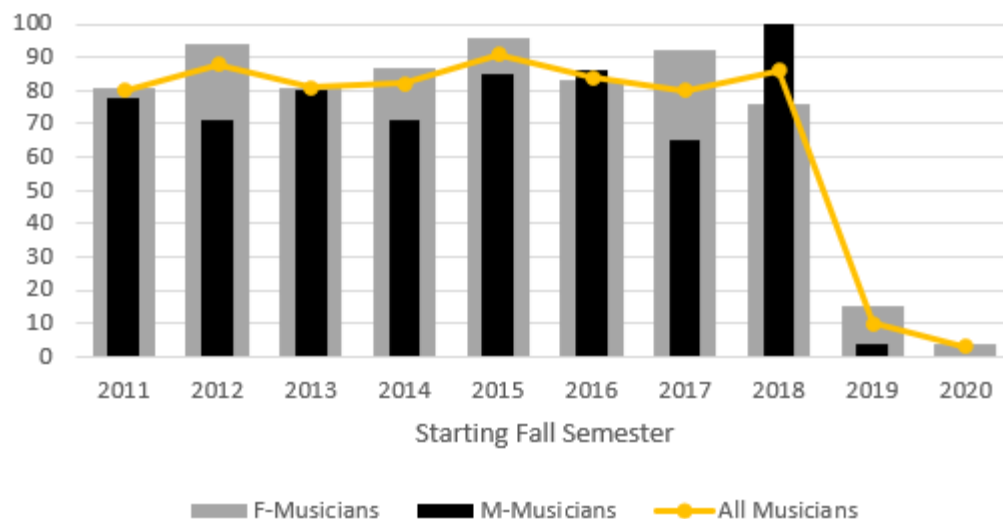

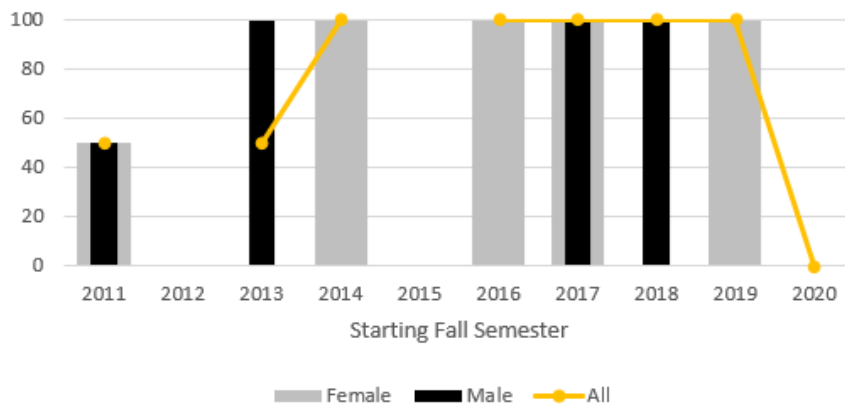

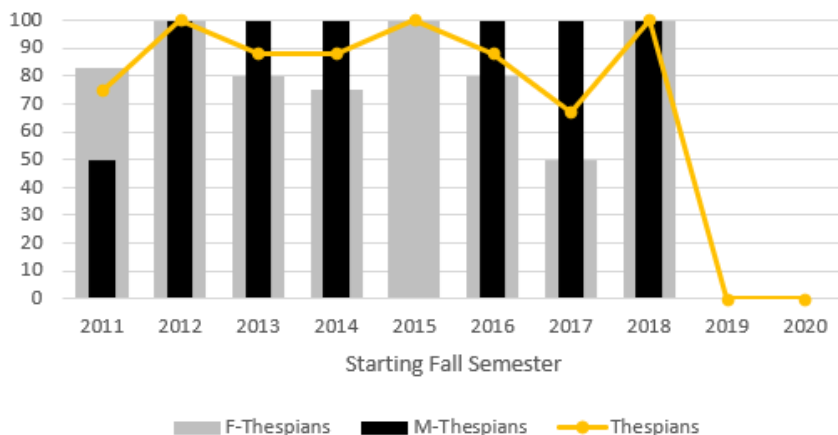

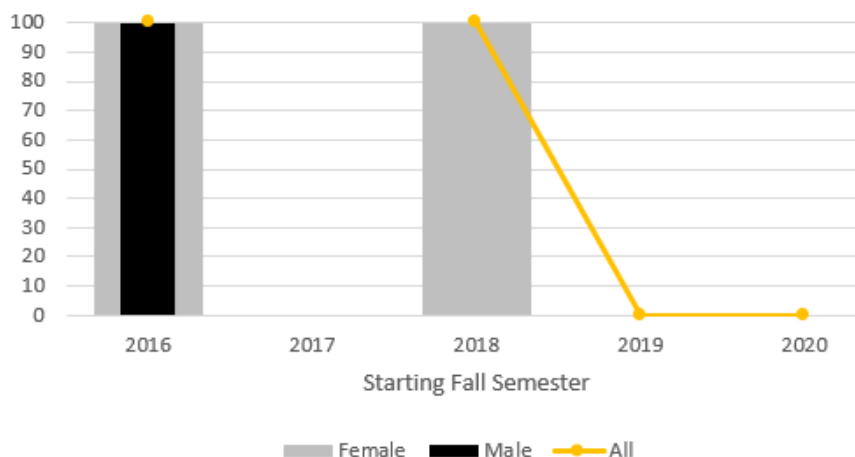
Graduation Rates for Student Publications Co-Curricular Participants



Graduation Rates for Theatre Co-Curricular Participants



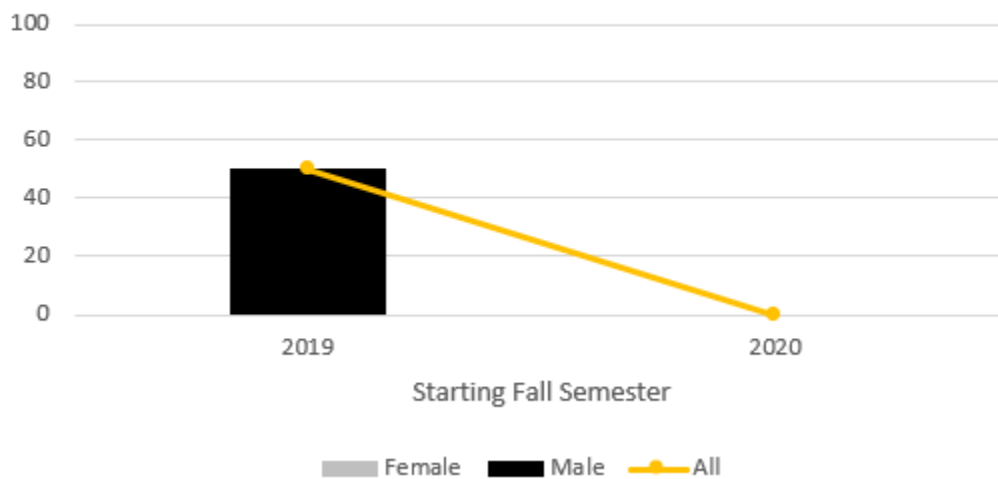
Graduation Rates for Forensics Co-Curricular Participants
