The FR-to-SO rate reflects the number of first time, full time, degree seeking freshmen from the prior year who returned in the fall of the reporting year. For example, the 2017 rate of $80.9 \%$ is based on the fact that of the 388 first time, full time freshmen in 2016, 314 returned in the fall of 2017.

The A.A. rate reflects the number of students who entered an associate's degree program three years prior to the reporting year and successfully completed their degree by September 1st of that year. For example, the 2017 rate of $75.0 \%$ is based on the fact that 4 students entered Dordt in 2014 intending to pursue an associate's degree. Of those 4 students, 3 completed their degree by September 1, 2017.

The B.A. rate reflects the number of students who entered a bachelor's degree program six years prior to the reporting year and successfully completed their degree by September 1st of that year. For example, the 2017 rate of $64.1 \%$ is based on the fact that 365 students entered Dordt in 2011 intending to pursue a bachelor's degree. Of those 365 students, 234 completed their degree by September 1, 2017.
