

## Discovery Days COVID-19 protocols

Below we have outlined the health protocols Dordt will have in place to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 on campus during Discovery Days. Parents, campers, and Discovery Days staff are expected to adhere to these expectations.

- Campers and parents will be expected to follow Dordt's COVID-19 protocols while on campus. Currently, those are to follow social distancing guidelines and wear a mask while indoors. Masks are not required inside the dorm rooms when campers are with their roommates. While these protocols are subject to change, we cannot guarantee that they will be relaxed by June. You should not attend camp if your camper cannot commit to following the guidelines as they are currently.
- Health forms must be completed and returned by May 1. Dordt will cancel any camp registration and offer a partial refund to those who do not complete the health form by our deadline.
- If a camper becomes sick, **they must be picked up within two hours**. Dordt Discovery Days staff will contact the parent. The student will remain in their room until their parent or guardian arrives.
- We will not be quarantining campers who are sick or allow them to stay on campus beyond the two hour pick-up window. We will also not be contact tracing campers.
- If you desire your camper to have a COVID test prior to leaving Sioux Center, you'll need to make those arrangements. Dordt will not have COVID testing available on campus during the summer. You may contact Sioux Center HyVee Pharmacy to schedule an appointment.
- If your camper becomes sick before Discovery Days camp or is in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, they will not be able to attend camp. We will offer a refund, minus credit card processing fees of \$10, for camp up to June 20, 2021.
- Dordt Dining will follow all safety protocols in serving campers.
- Dordt Discovery Days will have a camp nurse available from 8 a.m. – 4 p.m. for campers who have minor injuries or health questions.
